I. Approval of Minutes from October 9, 2005 Meeting

II. Junior Report – M. Muralidhar

- Dave recommends using the two outside banks of courts for matches and the interior bank of courts for warm-ups and overflow.
- Amy is willing to draft an entry form based on the entry that was used two years ago. Entry fees and prize money amounts need to be determined. In the last Freeman tournament, Region 5 provided \$2000 in prize money for A Flight and \$500 in prize money for B Flight.

- If possible, Amy will buy lunches from a vendor in Balboa Park.
- From the recent survey, Vijay, KC and Joe Silverman are willing to assist with tournaments.
- Amy can do the program.
- Ann G. will arrange the hotel.
- Dave C. is willing to be a referee and house 2 to 3 umpires from out of town.
- Murali can house someone from SCBA who is helping with the tournament, recruit line judges for the finals, and submit a request for joint City/Rec Council sponsorship.
- Ann Foy will chair the registration committee and will see if Joe Silverman is available to help.
- Thai will help recruit line judges and will update the perpetual trophies.
- The tournament will be held March 3-5, 2006.
